

Minutes of the Board of Licking Township Trustees, regular meeting, held at the Twp Hall Jacksontown, OH at 8:00pm on May 19, 2003.

Mr. Acord called the meeting to order with the following members present: Joe Cooper, Ron Acord, Dave Miller and Jill Linn.

Others present: Joe Walker, Erna Holland, Richard Cash, Marcia Phelps, Larry Lloyd, Steve Patterson and Charlie Davis.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Attached is a copy of all expenditures totaling \$8,764.22.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read, approved, and signed by the Trustees.

There are funds on hand or in the process of collection to pay the attached listed bills. _____, Clerk.

Motion was made by Mr. Cooper, seconded by Mr. Acord that he attached list of bills be approved as the lawful obligation of Licking Township and the Clerk be directed to issue warrants of the Township in payment of the same. Roll call: Cooper, yes; Acord, yes; Miller, yes.

CORRESPONDENCE: None

County Commissioner, Marcia Phelps, gave an update on the Bicentennial Wagon Train which will be passing through our township on July 1. A discussion took place regarding the township providing refreshments to the wagon train participants.

Larry Lloyd, from Licking County Recycling and Litter Prevention, mentioned that they will be working on bridge clean up on May 22. The trustees also signed a new recycling site contract. Mr. Cooper told Mr. Lloyd that Rhonda Carte will contact him regarding adding information to the township website.

Joe Walker turned in 1 permit totaling \$150. Mr. Walker mentioned that he met with the Assistant Prosecutor regarding The Woods at Buckeye Lake variance. Mr. Cooper mentioned that the prosecutors office asked that the township have a court reporter present at the variance hearing. Mr. Walker also stated that he had stopped at the residence on Ryan Road regarding the church/retreat grounds, however, no one was available. Mr. Walker stated that he will stop by the property at a later date. In regards to a tower being put in at the church on St. Rte. 13, it will be used for outreach to youth program. He mentioned that it will not be for commercial use and that they do have their FCC license. Paul Hanson will send Mr. Walker all the paper work regarding the tower. Mr. Walker also mentioned that he and Mr. Acord attended the meeting regarding the Hunts Landing project.

Mr. Cooper mentioned that the township will be receiving \$2000 from the Doris Orr Kaspar Foundation for the restoration of the Township Hall.

Mr. Cooper stated that he will wait on the prosecutors opinion regarding the Licking Rural Electrification's permit to install three phase transmission lines down Licking Trails Road.

Mr. Cooper mentioned that the mosquito control information will be put on the website.

Mr. Cooper asked about the tree on Lancaster Avenue. Charlie Davis stated that half the tree was in the townships right a way and the other half was on personal property. No decision was made.

Mr. Miller gave the road crew report. He mentioned that the dirt pile was removed, fence was repaired and patching was done.

Richard Cash mentioned that the state had removed all but two boat docks and that they had done a good job.

Mr. Acord asked about the burnt house on Avondale and

mentioned that the grass is extremely high. A discussion took place regarding property violations. Mr. Cooper asked each trustee to make a list of property that is not being maintained.

Mr. Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting seconded by Mr. Cooper. Roll call: Cooper, yes; Acord, yes; Miller, yes.
