

Minutes of the Board of Licking Township Trustees, Regular Meeting, held at the Township Hall Jacksontown, OH at 7:00pm on December 5, 2005.

Mr. Miller called the meeting to order with the following members present: Dave Miller, Ron Acord, Joe Cooper and Jill Linn.

Others present: Joe Walker, Richard Cash, Mike Briggs, Mike Wilson, Cindy Fields, Robert Snedden Sr., Bill Ours, Jeff Chorpenning, Steve Patterson and Charlie Davis.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Attached is a copy of all expenditures totaling \$40,276.21.

There are funds on hand or in the process of collection to pay the attached listed bills. _____, Clerk.

Motion was made by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Acord that the attached list of bills be approved as the lawful obligation of Licking Township and the Clerk be directed to issue warrants of the Township in payment of the same. Roll call: Miller, yes; Acord, yes; Cooper, yes.

CORRESPONDENCE:

1. Received the December Grassroots Clippings.
2. Received a Resolution vacating part of Hudson Lane in Harbor Hills.

Charlie Davis asked which part of Hudson Lane was being vacated. Mr. Acord explained that it is where the two pillars are.

Mike Wilson gave the Fire Co. report. There were 77 runs in November. Mr. Acord made a motion to increase the volunteer point money to \$7000.00, which is an increase of \$1000.00. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Miller, yes; Acord, yes; Cooper, yes. He also mentioned that they are still working on the truck specs.

Joe Walker had no zoning report. Mr. Miller mentioned that Joe Walker did a great job this year.

There were no responses to the Cemetery Advisory Board advertisement, however a few people have expressed an interest. Mr. Miller mentioned that he would like to be on the board.

There were no responses to the vacancy for the Zoning Board of Appeals advertisement. Richard Cash mentioned that he was interested. The Board will

meet on December 12th with the candidates. Mr. Cooper will ask Mr. Price to participate in the meetings.

Mr. Cooper mentioned that there will be an Open House on January 11th from 7:00pm - 9:00pm. Mr. Cooper would like to rent a space so that there is plenty of room to set things up and he also mentioned having refreshments.

After a discussion regarding problems with the website, Mr. Cooper made a motion to contract with Greenapple.com for one year so that we can host our own website. The cost will be a \$40 set up fee and then a \$20 monthly fee. Mr. Acord seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes. Mr. Miller abstained.

Mr. Cooper mentioned that on December 11th at 1:00pm at the Lakewood High School Library there will be a presentation of the Inventory of National Resources given by the Denison Environmental Sciences.

After a discussion regarding the parking, noise and people problems with Captain Woody's, Mr. Acord suggested meeting with the owners to discuss the problems and any solutions to help solve the problems. Mr. Miller mentioned that the meeting should include the sheriff.

Mr. Miller mentioned that the road crew will follow the snow schedule for the plowing of the roads. Mr. Miller will talk with the Harbor Hills residents and a few residents on Miller Avenue regarding the snow plows not being able to get down the road when they decide to park on the street.

Mr. Acord mentioned that the new blade will be in on Friday.

Mr. Miller mentioned that the stakes were put in at Mr. Sneddens'. Cindy Fields asked if a letter can be sent to the Dogwood Lakes Association stating what their boundaries are and to respect their property. She also asked that no snow be put in the yard. Mr. Miller will send a letter to the Dogwood Lakes Association but mentioned that the snow will go where the snow goes.

Bill Ours mentioned that he is the head of the Building Committee in Harbor Hills and will work with the Zoning Inspector and Trustees to make sure things are done correctly.

New Bowling Green Township Trustee, Jeff Chorpenning introduced himself.

Mr. Acord made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Miller, yes; Acord, yes; Cooper, yes.
