

Minutes of the Board of Licking Township Trustees, Regular Meeting held at the Township Hall, Jacksontown, OH at 7:00pm on January 17, 2006.

Jill Linn called the meeting to order with the following members present: Ron Acord, Joe Cooper, Dave Miller and Jill Linn.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read, approved and signed by the Trustees.

Attached is a copy of all expenditures totaling \$8,151.35.

Motion was made by Mr. Acord, seconded by Mr. Cooper that the attached list of bills be approved as the lawful obligation of Licking Township and the Fiscal Officer be directed to issue the warrants of the Township in payment of the same. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes.

Larry Gerlach read and encouraged residents to read the new zoning resolution in which he believes that eminent domain is being initiated.

Mr. Cooper agreed that the residents should read the new zoning resolution but doesn't believe that eminent domain is being initiated. Mr. Cooper mentioned that there will be a Zoning Commission meeting on January 25th at 6:30pm where discussion will take place regarding the new zoning resolution.

Other residents gave their concerns regarding the proposed zoning resolution. Mr. Miller mentioned that everyone should have a chance to read it and that doing so in 90 days isn't long enough.

There was no Fire Co. report.

Mr. Walker turned in one permit totaling \$150.

Mr. Miller thanked the road crew for posting the weight limit signs and he turned in the reports to the engineers' office.

In regards to the noise surrounding Captain Woody's, Mr. Cooper will try to set up a meeting with Mr. Mar to discuss the concerns with the parking, property damage, the fighting and rude behavior by his customers. Mr. Cooper will see what Mr. Mar can do to help the situation before setting up a meeting with Randy Thorp for his suggestions. Mr. Cooper also mentioned that the township has authority to have parking enforced and gave that information to the trustees.

Mr. Cooper also gave the trustees a new zoning rate fee schedule to look over.

Mr. Cooper made a motion to advertise for the cemetery mowing bid. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes.

Mr. Miller made a motion to have Mike Wilson take the fire truck specs to Tony Stocco for his approval. Mr. Cooper seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes.

Mr. Miller mentioned that he hasn't received the information from Tony Stocco regarding Mr. Sneddens' property.

Mr. Cooper asked the trustees to look over the proposed resolution for HB 299 which gives the township the ability to receive impact fees from new developments.

Richard Cash made that suggestion to check with New Albany since they do receive money from impact fees.

Mr. Miller mentioned that if you bring to him your weathered flags he will dispose of them properly through the American Legion.
