

Minutes of the Board of Licking Township Trustees, Regular Meeting, held at the Fire Co. Station 3, Jacksontown, OH at 7:00pm on August 21, 2006.

Mr. Acord called the meeting to order with the following members present: Ron Acord, Joe Cooper, Dave Miller and Jill Linn.

Others present: Joseph Hart, Bill Ours, Joe Walker, Richard Cash, Cindy Fields, Robert Snedden Sr., Dan Dodd, Charles Prince, Steve Patterson and Charlie Davis.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Minutes of the July 17, 2006 meeting were read, approved and signed by the Trustees.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read, approved and signed by the Trustees.

Mr. Walker turned in 5 permits totaling \$750. He checked the property on Chowning and observed nothing. He also mentioned that Mr. Guyer will need a variance to build any new buildings.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve Resolution AP-1: For the restriction of parking along on roadway or right of way of Avondale Road, Licking Township, Licking County Ohio. Mr. Acord seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes. The resolution is on file with the Fiscal Officer.

Mr. Cooper made a motion to approve Resolution AP-2: For the alteration of the penalties imposed for parking on roadway or right of way of Avondale Road, Licking Township, Licking County Ohio. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes. The resolution is on file with the Fiscal Officer.

Mr. Acord made a motion to approve Resolution AP-3: For the establishment of fines regarding parking on roadway or right of way of Avondale Road, Licking Township, Licking County Ohio. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes. The resolution is on file with the Fiscal Officer.

Mr. Cooper made a motion to approve Resolution AP-4: For the establishment of payment of fines regarding parking on the roadway or right of way of Avondale Road, Licking Township, Licking County Ohio. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes. The resolution is on file with the Fiscal Officer

Mr. Cooper made a motion to approve Resolution AP-5: For the establishment of impoundment regarding parking on roadway or right of way of Avondale Road, Licking Township, Licking County Ohio. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes.

A discussion took place regarding the resolutions. The resolutions will be posted in five places in the Township for 30 days and will be published in the Advocate for three consecutive weeks.

Mr. Miller made a motion to rescind the motion made on June 19, 2006 raising the zoning permit fees. Mr. Acord seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes.

Mr. Cooper made a motion to submit the following to the Zoning Commission to consider the text amendment: The Board of Township Trustees shall by resolution establish a schedule of fees, charges, and expenses and a collection procedure for zoning permits, amendments, appeals, variances, conditional use permits, plan approvals, and other matters pertaining to the administration and enforcement of this resolution requiring investigations, inspections, legal advertising, postage and other expenses. The schedule of fees shall be available from the zoning inspector, and may be altered or amended only by the Board of Township Trustees. No permit will be issued until the appropriate fee had been paid and no hearing or appeal will be conducted until the requested deposit has been posted with the Licking Township Zoning Clerk. Applicants or appellants are responsible for all charges and expenses to conduct a hearing or appeal. Mr. Acord seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes.

After a discussion, Mr. Cooper made a motion to utilize the fee schedule from 2/16/99 and that the difference between the fees collected from 6/19/06 until present be refunded. Mr. Walker will continue to use the 2/16/99 fee schedule. Mr. Acord seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes. Mr. Walker will give the Fiscal Officer the list of refunds.

Mr. Miller will try to schedule a meeting with Tim Lollo and all Trustees regarding Somerset Road.

Mr. Cooper received an email from Marge Howard asking to rent the Township Hall for the Garden Club in November. The Trustees had no objections.

Mr. Miller mentioned that the truck has some rust in the midsection of the frame and that Ziebart will be able to take care of it for around \$200.

Dan Dodd, candidate for the 91st Ohio House District attended the meeting.

Robert Snedden asked about his zoning. Mr. Acord mentioned that they are working on the information.
