Mr. Acord called the meeting to order with the following members present: Ron Acord, Dave Miller and Jill Linn. Joe Cooper was absent.

CORRESPONDENCE:

1. Received information from the LCPC regarding vacating a portion of Amherst Road (TR 386).

Mike Briggs gave the Fire Co. report. He turned in \$5 for an EMS report. The squad brakes are repaired and it's back in service. The admission for the haunted house is a can of food on Friday and \$5 on Saturday.

Joe Walker turned in 3 permits totaling \$370. He is working on a complaint and mentioned that they may need to go to court. The resident at 319 Edgewater Beach Blvd. built a privacy fence on the adjoining property line and added a roof from the garage to the fence.

Mr. Acord mentioned that the pipe is in on Roberta Drive and received the money from the residents. Mr. Miller mentioned that in the future they should run a disk down through it. Mr. Acord mentioned that it will need to be done in the spring and they will try to fix the driveways.

Mr. Acord mentioned that there are two trees west of the firehouse that may need to be removed. He also mentioned that at Logan Avenue and Avondale there is a tree that Mr. Anderson would like to have removed. The trustees will look at it.

Mr. Miller mentioned that the date for the records policy will be done at the next meeting.

Mr. Miller mentioned that there are six places where berm will need to be put down.

Robert Snedden showed the trustees a map of Somerset Road. Mr. Miller mentioned that they are in consultation with Ken Oswalt and cannot commit or take action on the situation. Robert mentioned that it is time to do something.

Joe Walker asked if he can purchase dividers for the filing cabinets. Mr. Miller said yes. Mr. Miller will also purchase 3 to 4 file cabinets.

Mr. Acord brought in a receipt to show that his driveway was not paved at the same time that his road was done.

Richard Cash mentioned that the discussion was whether you did or did not motorpave over blacktop. Mr. Acord did agree that he motor paved over the old blacktop to improve the road.

Robert Snedden asked if he was zoned agriculture. Joe Walker mentioned that he is zoned agricultural/residential. A discussion about the zoning followed.
