

Minutes of the Board of Licking Township Trustees, Regular Meeting, held at the Fire Co. Station 3, Jacksontown, OH at 7:00pm on July 16, 2007.

There was no fire report.

Joe Walker turned in 1 permit totaling \$50. He mentioned that Mr. Jedlicki is building a building for farm equipment. Marshall Eubanks thanked Mr. Walker for finding the information out.

Mr. Miller called Judy Edwards regarding The Woods, however, Judy is on vacation.

The road bids were opened. Mr. Miller mentioned that the bids were confusing so Smalls Asphalt Paving submitted one bid in feet and one bid in yards.

Mr. Acord mentioned that the Roberta Drive residents did not want the pipe that the Trustees had ordered and wasn't sure if the Trustees want to go ahead and purchase the pipe. Mr. Miller made a motion to purchase the pipe. Mr. Cooper seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Cooper, yes; Miller, yes. The Trustees will let the residents know that a decision will need to be made to either put in the pipe or have an open ditch by the August 20th meeting. If they go with purchasing their own pipe it will need to be there by August 20th.

Mr. Cooper read a letter from the individual who vandalized township signs. He also mentioned that the individual made restitution.

Mr. Cooper mentioned that he sent a note to the Zoning Commission Board alternate Denise Delagrange to see if she would be interested in filling the vacancy left by Troy Dunlap. Mr. Cooper will follow up.

Mr. Acord mentioned that Tim Lollo will send a letter to Judy Edwards regarding a tree on Logan.

Ed Rickles, from The Woods, asked for help and support from the Trustees regarding the parking problem, fights and trash from the bar patrons. He gave the Trustees pictures. He suggested parking between certain times. Other residents mentioned the same. A discussion followed. Bill Ours mentioned that the association can have a dues system in which they would be able to hire an officer to patrol the area.

Robert Snedden mentioned that his property is grandfathered in. He asked Mr. Miller if he talked with Tim Lollo at the same time he talked to him regarding The Woods problem. Mr. Miller said no because he was talking to Tim Lollo about The Woods. Mr. Acord is working with Judy Edwards on the situation.

Cindy Fields asked for the minutes that were not recorded and why. She asked if anyone is able to make a correction to the minutes. Mr. Cooper said that the meeting is a meeting of the Trustees and that the minutes can only be approved or corrected by the Trustees. Cindy mentioned that she did not feel that the minutes are detailed enough. She mentioned that Robert Snedden purchased his property in 1963 prior to the Dogwood Lakes development and that there is no right of way on his property line to Roley Hills Road.
