Mr. Acord made a motion to purchase 472 feet of fence to be placed at Fleatown Cemetery and Green Cemetery. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Miller, yes.

Mr. Miller read and made a motion to accept the Resolution to Request That the County Auditor Certify Valuation and Revenue Information Pursuant To R.C. 5705.03(B). Mr. Acord seconded the motion. Roll call: Acord, yes; Miller, yes. The resolution is on file with the Fiscal Officer.

Mr. Acord discussed the drainpipe and March flood. The residents on Roberta Drive are looking at options to install a 6" or 8" pipe. The residents will let the Trustees know what they decide after they all meet. The township will dig the ditch. Mr. Hart commented on the drain elevation and gravity flow and expressed the need for an 8" pipe.
