

Minutes of the Board of Licking Township Trustees, Regular Meeting held at the Fire Co., Station 3, Jacksontown, OH at 7:00pm on June 21, 2010.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Mr. Hart called the meeting to order with the following members present: Joseph Hart, Ronald Acord and Jill Linn. David Miller arrived at 7:02pm.

Others Present: Joe Walker, Bill Ours, Charles Prince, Rhonda Carte, Rick Rife and Steve Patterson.

The financial reports were given to the Trustees.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the expenditures totaling \$12,163.76. Mr. Acord seconded the motion. Roll call: Hart, yes; Acord, yes; Miller, yes.

There are funds on hand or in the process of collection to pay the attached listed bills. \_\_\_\_\_, Fiscal Officer.

The Trustees gave permission for the fiscal officer to keep the money in CDARS for one year at .45% interest.

The Trustees and Steve Patterson decided that it was not necessary to have an employee meeting with the insurance agency.

In regards to the letter received by Mike Poling, the roads in question are county roads and have been mowed.

Mr. Miller mentioned that he was late to the meeting because he was fielding a call from a resident on Dorsey Mill Road regarding a culvert.

Mr. Acord mentioned that the squad was repaired.

Mr. Walker had no permits. In regards to the weeds on Allison Drive, Mr. Walker mentioned that the resident will mow them. There was a complaint made of weeds on Overdrive. Mr. Miller said that if it is a health issue then they need to call the health department. Mr. Walker said that the property is in litigation and he will stay on top of it.

Steve Patterson mentioned that the guardrail is fixed on White Chapel. He also mentioned that the ditch was done in Harbor Hills.

Mr. Hart asked about the bid for tree trimming. Mr. Miller has not received a response from the people he called. Mr. Hart gave Mr. Miller a business card from Tim's Total Tree Service and Bill Ours will give Mr. Miller information for Gary Sloan so that they can be called to see if they would like to place a bid.

Mr. Miller mentioned that the residents who live north of the cemetery would like the fence replaced and that they will pay half. The residents and Mr. Miller will get estimates.

Mr. Miller turned in the list for road repairs. A discussion took place regarding the roads on the list.

Mr. Hart made a motion that the Township approve the list of potential roads to be bid for resurfacing and or repairs for 2010 as presented by Mr. Miller revising this list by removing Liberty and adding the two railroad crossings which are South Fork and White Chapel and adding Kenyon Place. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Hart, yes; Acord, yes; Miller, yes.

The bids will be due July 17<sup>th</sup> and opened July 19<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Hart gave Mr. Miller a copy of a recorded easement that provides to the township, which was recorded in 1935, a perpetual easement which goes with all the land owners that establishes our right to have a public road there. It was

given to Rhonda Carte with the understanding that she would give it to Charles Krumm.

The zoning text was recorded and copies will be left for the Trustees and Zoning Inspector at the Township Hall.

Mr. Miller mentioned that they worked with a piece of equipment called a durapatcher which seals the cracks on the roads. The cost for the equipment is \$61,654.50. After a discussion regarding the material which will be needed and road projects set for this year, the fiscal officer would like to make sure the money is there to purchase the equipment.

Mr. Miller mentioned that the truck needs kingpins and the backhoe gas peddle sticks so both will need to be repaired.

Rhonda Carte asked how she would appeal a zoning permit. Mr. Hart said you go through the Zoning Board of Appeals. Mr. Walker said that she should call Doug Price. A discussion took place regarding the Avondale area. Rhonda said again that no one cares about that area. Mr. Hart said that he thinks that Rhonda thinks that the Trustees have jurisdiction over things that they don't have. Mr. Hart, again, said that if he lived in that community that he would take up a legal petition to shut down the liquor license at Papa Boos and Captain Woody's.

Rick Rife mentioned that the parking issue is a mess on the lake. A discussion followed. As far as the park, Mr. Hart mentioned that they don't govern private property so if they have a problem then they need to talk with Paul & Cindy Ripko.

Mr. Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:37pm. Mr. Acord seconded the motion. Roll call: Hart, yes; Acord, yes; Miller, yes.
