

Minutes of the Board of Licking Township Trustees, Regular Meeting held at the Fire Co., Station 3, Jacksontown, OH at 7:30pm on March 7, 2011.

Mr. Hart called the meeting to order with the following members present: Joseph Hart, David Miller and Jill Linn. Ronald Acord was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

1. Received information from the Licking County Water and Wastewater.

Mike Briggs left Mr. Hart the Fire Co. report. There were 64 runs in the month of February. The Fiscal Officer should be receiving a training grant check.

Joe Walker turned in 2 permits totaling \$240.00. He mentioned that he has the township maps that were in the township hall. He also mentioned that a company from Columbus wants to put up a communication tower on property

on St. Rt. 13 in which Mr. Walker told them to check with the airport because we have no authority over that.

Steve Patterson mentioned that the truck will go to Ervins Auto Body tomorrow.

Mr. Miller mentioned that the salt was delivered.

The health insurance renewal will be discussed at the next meeting. A discussion followed.

Mr. Miller said that Jim Miller will look in to the single source trash hauler and mentioned that we might need a trash district. Jim Miller will get back with Mr. Miller. A discussion followed regarding commercial accounts.

Mr. Miller and Steve Patterson will do a sign inventory for the reflective signs and is applying for a grant.

Mr. Hart asked if they have identified the places where 'stop ahead' signs will need to go. Mr. Miller said no but that they will work on it.

Greg Smith mentioned the problem that he is having with the neighbors' dog constantly barking and asked what can be done. Mr. Hart mentioned that we don't have a noise control policy. Mr. Walker said that he can call the sheriffs' office and file a complaint. Mr. Hart informed him that any resident has the right to take a proposed zoning amendment to the Licking Township Zoning Commission. A discussion followed.

Greg Smith asked why South Fork is so icy on the township side but not the Heath side. He was told that Heath uses brine water.

Mr. Hart made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:40pm. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Hart, yes; Miller, yes.
