

Minutes of the Board of Licking Township Trustees, Regular Meeting held at the Fire Co., Station 3, Jacksontown, OH at 7:30pm on June 6, 2011.

Mr. Hart called the meeting to order with the following members present: Joseph Hart, David Miller and Ronald Acord. Jill Linn was absent.

Joe Walker issued one permit but had nothing to turn in. He talked with a resident on Cristland Hills Road and was told that he would be cleaning up the property. He also checked on a parking problem on Avondale Road and there was nothing there now.

Mr. Miller thanked the road crew for putting in the tile in Harbor Hills.

Mr. Miller went and looked at a situation on Lakeview Drive where there are railroad ties that are in the right of way. Mr. Hart will find out who owns the property and have a letter sent to them to have the items removed since it is in a clear zone.

Mr. Miller said that they need to review the roads on the list before a decision is made.

Mr. Miller said that he received a call from the sheriffs' office regarding a problem on Terrace Avenue where someone parked a boat in the wrong place. The owner of the boat moved it. A discussion followed regarding the area.

Mr. Miller mentioned that they received 250 gallons of emulsion, which is a summer mix.

Ed Monroe asked about the trash hauling. Mr. Miller said that he would like to have public hearings in July and August. A discussion followed regarding fees that other townships pay.

Mr. Acord made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:10pm. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Roll call: Hart, yes; Miller, yes; Acord, yes.
